We offer a specialised enquiry and literature search service. All you need to do is let us know what information you need and we will do the searching for you. We carry out complex searches on clinical and business management databases such as The Cochrane Library, Medline, CINAHL, PsycINFO, Health Business Elite and NHS Evidence. We aim to find the best available evidence to support patient care, service development, research and continuing professional development.

RESOURCES

Both libraries provides access to journals and books in print and electronic formats. Members are allowed to borrow up to twelve books. Both libraries provide access to loans and returns 24/7 via self-issue machines.
