



Medical Masterclass textbooks are divided into 12 modules covering all areas of medical practice and cover the clinical specialities that appear in the MRCP(UK) exams. 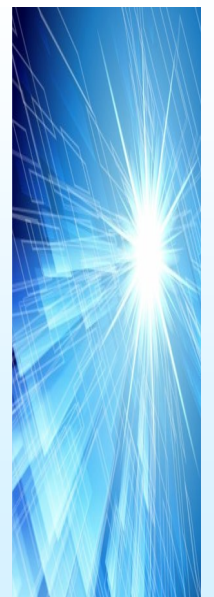

Medical Masterclass and other postgraduate medical examination resources



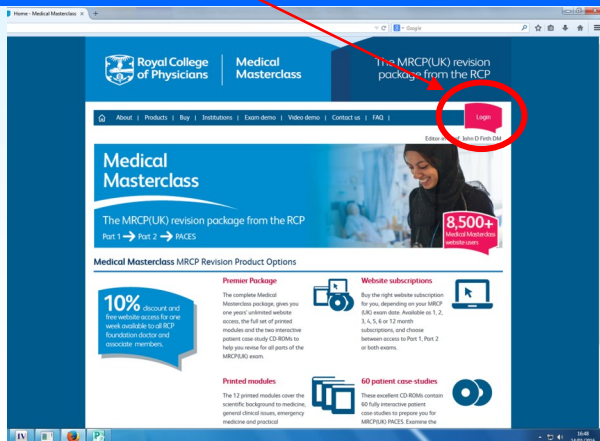
This helpsheet tells you how to register for Medical Masterclass online exam resources. There is also a range of accompanying books (2008 edition) available to loan from the library.

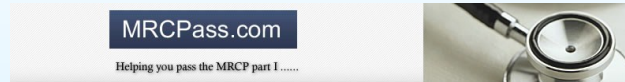
2) We will then take some details from you and set up an account for you and issue you with a username and password.
