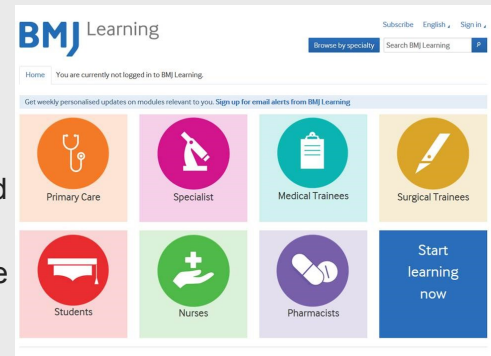

You have access to:

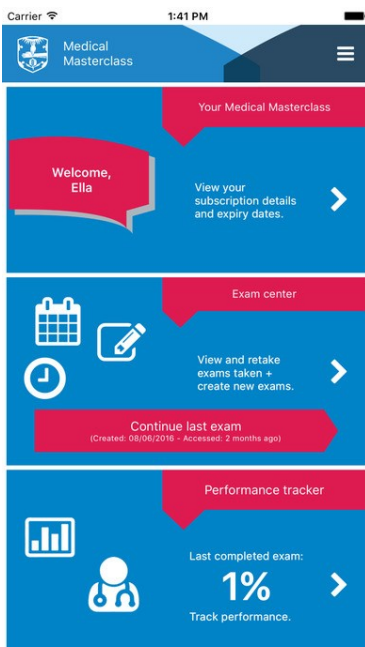
- Over 1000 interactive learning modules, across over 70 specialty areas

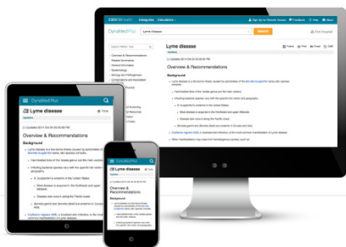

3. Signing on to the App: Go to your desktop version of *Dynamed Plus* and click on "Get the Dynamed Plus Mobile App" under the Spotlight section of the product. Submit your email address, open up the email on your mobile device and following the instructions provided.
4. You can access the desktop version of *Dynamed Plus* from the Trust intranet without a password or from the library website www.sonhsiks.com or www.openathens.net with an Athens password.
